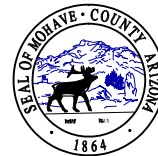

Additional Flu Clinics Scheduled

November 29, 2006 (Kingman, AZ) – The Mohave County Department of Public Health (MCDPH) has received the remainder of its flu vaccine order. Christy Bronston, Nursing Services Manager, stated “The Nursing Division will be holding additional flu shot clinics that are tentatively set for Lake Havasu on December 15th and Kingman and Bullhead on December 18th. We have not confirmed the locations for the clinics at this time.”

To make an appointment, individuals should contact their local public health nursing office Monday, December 4th through Thursday, December 14th from 8:00am – 4:00pm:

The cost for the flu vaccine is \$30.00. We will bill Medicare Part B only if Medicare is the individual’s primary insurance. Medicare cards must be brought to the appointment. Pneumonia vaccine is also available and the cost is \$45.00.

MCDPH reminds residents that there are some simple things people can do to reduce the spread of illness: cover your mouth when you cough or sneeze, wash hands with soap and hot water often, and stay home if you are sick.
